## **Section 2: Participation**

Please mark (x) in each box that applies. Please check for times and locations.

1. **General** – Mark this box if you are attending the General Retreat **ONLY**. This retreat is Friday – Sunday, November 19–21, 2010. All adults, if you are attending the retreat during this time, should check this box.
2. **Young Adult** – Mark this box if you are attending this retreat and you are between the ages of 18 – 23. Though you are not totally excluded from the general retreat, we have prepared this facet of the retreat to meet and minister to you personally and intimately. It still takes place Friday–Sunday, November 19–21, 2010, so that you may also attend every aspect of the General Retreat that you desire. Your 15 required workshops can come from the General Retreat list as well as the Young Adult workshop list. Please transcribe those codes on the Retreat Registration Form in Section 8. You are also asked to attend at least 3 Worship Services. Choose those from the list and write in Section 8.
3. **Deliverance Interviews** – Mark this box if you hear the Spirit of God leading you to receive from Him via the Deliverance Interview. You will be notified in advance of the day and time of your appointment. It is open to every adult and young adult, but is not geared toward youth. It is designed to temper your heart to be open to the deliverance process of God.
4. **Pastor’s** – Mark this box if you are attending the Pastor’s Retreat **ONLY**. This retreat is Thursday, November 18, 2010. Only members of the Governmental Ministry (Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor, and Teacher) as well as Bishops, Elders, and ministry leaders can attend. LFCM, in conjunction with Pure Life Ministries, will conduct a Purity Weekend for Pastors. This retreat will prepare you to restore broken relationships, live pure amid unclean atmospheres, protect your home from ungodly influences, and honor God with your thoughts.
5. **Youth** – All youth, ages 0–17 must mark this box. This not only allows us to make sure all youth have appropriate accommodations, but that they also will be accounted for in the Youth Retreat. The Youth Retreat is created just for the youth.
6. **Accountability Partner** – LFCM – SRHR would like to provide to any and every attendee that desires, a confidential accountability partner to help you walk the path of healing, deliverance, restoration and wholeness. Your accountability partner will help you bear your infirmities and lead you as you walk with Jesus the Christ. Marking this box means you are requesting an accountability partner and that you are agreeing to work with and walk in agreement with him/her and the Holy Spirit during this retreat.
7. **Pastor’s and General** – Mark this box if you are attending **BOTH** the Pastor’s Retreat and the General Retreat. Only individuals that are qualified to attend the Pastor’s Retreat can attend both. For qualifications see above.
8. **Healing Workshops** – Healing Workshops are designed so that you, the attendee, can receive the optimum from God during this weekend. They convene on Thursday, November 18, 2010 in conjunction with the Deliverance Interviews that also takes place on Thursday. Check this box if you desire to attend the Healing WordShops. You must register also so plan to arrive at 9:30 A.M. Choose the WordShops and times that you desire to attend from the list and indicate it on the Retreat Registration Form Section 8.
9. Please check this box if you are attending the CEU seminars for CEU credit. The price for each seminar is \$30.00, However you may attend CEU seminars for no charge if CEU’s credits are not desired.

10. Please indicate any allergies that you or your child possesses (food, fabrics, etc.). This is especially important for us regarding youth.
11. List any medication(s) if any that you or your child is currently/will be taking? LFCM will not be held responsible for administering any medications to any youth or adult. That will be the responsibility of the attendee. Also, storage of any medication is your responsibility. You will be held legally responsible for any accidents that take place because your medications were used improperly and/or illegally.
12. Inform us if you or your child possesses special needs so that we can make the necessary accommodations. LFCM welcomes all individuals to attend any and all of our services and retreats. We do not discriminate based on race, creed, color, economic status or disability.
13. Please write the name of one (1) adult that will be responsible for the attending child/children. This adult **MUST** be attending the retreat (Pastor's and/or General). It is preferred that this person be the legal parent of the child. Adults that have been given custodial right by the parent(s) are acceptable. This adult can be a sibling or a healthcare provider. An unrelated individual between the ages of 18 – 25 without consent is not acceptable.
14. Please provide a phone number where the adult indicated in number 12 can be reached in case of emergency. A cell phone is highly acceptable and it is your responsibility to be accessible in case of emergency or in any case that the ministry leaders of LFCM deem necessary.
15. Please check and initial this box **AFTER** reading the disclaimer below.

Your signature of consent and/or declaration of responses places you in contract with LFCM to observe all rules of conduct. Any infraction of these rules is grounds for immediate loss of LFCM provided accommodations and removal from the premises. The nature of this retreat requires a no tolerance stance on inappropriate behavior and activity not in accordance with the holiness of scripture. LFCM is committed to the healing and restoration of all its guests and wants to ensure an environment that will provide the atmosphere that the miracles, signs, and wonders that God intends can manifest.

16. This box is reserved for the signature of the parent/guardian of the attending youth during this retreat. Your signature means that you are responsible for the youth and are willing to be contacted in case of emergency.

You cannot receive your room key until you attend the orientation. Please note, we suggest that you coordinate arriving and attending the orientation with your roommate so that you both/all can receive your room keys at the same time. Though we desire to keep your selected roommate(s), if all parties do not arrive at an adequate time, we cannot guarantee that roommate choice. **Youth MUST** attend the orientation with their parent/guardian.

Please choose your orientation time from this list and plan to be on time. There is no orientation after Saturday, November 20, 2010 at 10:00 A.M. Early orientation is November 13, 2010 and will be held at LFC, 1750 West 103<sup>rd</sup>, Chicago, IL 60643, not the hotel.

*Please know that at least one adult must be in a room with youth. The processing fee for hotel accommodations is \$45.00 per person. No room request/retreat registration is complete until the hotel accommodation form (Section 4) is properly filled out, signed and your \$45.00 per person (regardless of age), processing fee is received. It is required as part of a complete registration.*

#### **Hotel Accommodation Form**

Weekend on-site accommodations are available to individuals based on the following criteria.

- A. The first 500 attendees who submit a completed registration form (see page 1) **by August 31, 2010**, will receive hotel accommodations for the price of **\$45.00 per person for Friday and Saturday**. (You will be notified in advance if your registration is received after this cutoff).
- B. The next 500 attendees who submit a completed registration form (see page 1) from **September 1 – October 31, 2010**, will receive hotel accommodations for the processing fee of **\$85.00 per person for Friday and Saturday**. (Again, you will be notified if you fall within this time).
- C. Attendees who submit a completed registration **after October 31** will receive hotel accommodation for **\$85.00 per night, per person**.

All monies are non-refundable/nontransferable (see Accommodations Policy below). Hotel accommodations must be made through LFCM @ (773) 779-2900. **Do not call The Westin O'Hare directly**. After you have attended your assigned orientation, hotel rooms will be assigned on first come first served basis as they become available. All roommates must be present or you could be assigned another roommate. Check-in and out must be done through LFC only. Final checkout is at noon on Sunday. Check-in must be done in person with a **valid photo ID and your registration confirmation letter issued by the LFCM office**. All accommodations are based upon single, double, triple, and quadruple occupancy. Roommate preference can only be granted if the individual is registered at the time of request and only mutual roommate requests will be considered. All youths must be in a room with at least one adult (Parent or Guardian).

The price for hotel accommodations for Pastors and Leaders attending the Pastor's Retreat (Thursday November 18, 2010) is \$85.00.

## **Accommodation Guarantee for Incidentals**

A \$45.00 processing fee for hotel accommodations, per person per room is required to hold your room reservation. **Parking is \$10.00 a day with in and out privileges. Parking vouchers are given during the registration. Parking fee is paid directly to the hotel.**

## **Section 5: Financial** (See page 8 for a Partnership Letter)

1. This retreat cannot be successful without the gracious gifts and donations from you our partners. We ask that you take the time to seek the Holy Spirit for what amount He is requiring you to

sow into the healing, deliverance, restoration, and wholeness of His sons and daughters. Please know that every donation sown into the Kingdom is used in the Kingdom.

2. The hotel room processing fee is either \$45.00 per person if you are registering before August 31, 2009, or \$85.00 per person if you are registering September 1–October 31, 2009, or \$85.00 per person per night if you are registering after October 31, 2009. Please write the amount here.
3. This is the third year we are creating a Healing Quilt. It is made of colored squares that possess the names of people in your life that you believe God will heal on all levels. Each square is \$8 per person. Check this box to purchase a healing square. The next step is to write the name of the person and the prayer code in Section 8. All prayer codes are on pg. 12. Use Section 9 if additional space is needed.

Due to the nature of the subject matter, the highest level of confidentiality will be adhered to. Therefore, no cameras or taping devices of any kind including camera phones will be permitted in any area including worship services, seven wonders room, and WordShop rooms, for use by any unauthorized personnel. **LFCM** does not endorse or support any form of relationally or sexually deviant/immoral behavior, i.e., conversations, gestures, homosexuality, lesbianism, bestiality, or incest. We have made a commitment to serve as vessels that God can use to express His unconditional love, hope, healing, and complete restoration to both the victim and the victimizer. Therefore, we ask that all retreat participants be sensitive to the ministry of the Holy Spirit, and that our behavior be based upon holiness and accountability, honoring the name and the character of Jesus Christ, and be governed by the Word of God. The Westin O’Hare does not permit smoking in any area of the hotel.
